elementary schools, either by utilizing its own personnel or by contracting with an outside provider that is properly licensed to provide child care services ("child care provider").

In those cases where the District chooses to contract with an outside provider, it shall adhere to the following procedures with respect to the selection of a provider. Child care services are to be offered:

2. Proposals shall be evaluated jointly by the superintendent and principal of the elementary school facilities and principal of the elementary school where the services are to be offered, with assistance from the District's Director of Finance and Administration Management. Based on consideration of the proposals and input from the officials involved in the evaluation process, the superintendent shall determine to whom a contract will be awarded for the provision of child care services at the elementary school.
3. The child care provider selected shall be required to submit a proposal to the District before providing any child care services. The proposal must include a schedule of the provider's fees and services.
4. Unless the District chooses to discontinue or reduce child care services at an elementary school or chooses to offer child care services at an elementary school by utilizing its own personnel, it shall prepare to offer child care services no less frequently than once every year.
