2. All adopted textbooks for future student growth.
3. All consumable instructional materials that are necessary for student learning on a daily or regular basis in place of textbooks.
4. Teacher guides and manuals.
5. Replacement textbooks that are damaged or lost.

School and departmental budgets include the following resources and materials:

1. Textbooks that were previously used but are beyond those needed for the current year.
2. All supplemental textbooks for use in the classroom, including textbooks used in the previous course of study and Board-adopted series, at the discretion of a teacher.
3. Other supplemental materials that are an integral part of a Board-adopted series.
4. Consumable items such as English portfolios, student notebooks, etc.
5. All supplementary materials that are an integral part of a Board-adopted series and deemed necessary for student learning.

6. All textbooks upgraded to a new edition at the choice of the school or instructional program and not mandated by the district.
